

#### **Ambulance System Run Volume:**

Frontier Volume <100 Responses (23)..35.9% Low Volume

100 to 500 Responses (21)......32.8% Moderate Volume

>500 to 1000 Responses (7) ......10.9% High Volume >1000 Responses (13).....20.3%

55.3% of Wyoming Ambulance Services have less than 1 response per day
