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- *NEW CPT Codes for 2010*
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### **2010 CPT Code Changes**

The National Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program under the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recently provided us with the approved CPT Code list and approved reimbursement rates. Please see the attached list. A few things we wanted to mention in particular are:

- Codes 57522-58100-58110 have reimbursement rules (clarification about under what circumstances we can or can not provide payment)
- We can now reimburse for supplies and materials associated with office visits. Please use this NEW CODE 99070.
- Office Consultation codes 99241-99242-99243 are no longer applicable and we will now reimburse at the New Patient office visit rates.

### **January is Cervical Cancer / Cervical Health Awareness Month**

January is Cervical Cancer / Cervical Health Awareness Month. Wyoming is currently ranked 47<sup>th</sup> in the nation (third from last) in Pap screenings for women 18-64. This means that **approximately 32,000 Wyoming women are currently overdue for a Pap test!** An estimated 78.4% of Wyoming women 18 and older (with a cervix) have had a Pap test within the past 3 years. The U.S. median is 82.9% and the U.S. Goal is 90%. Please find enclosed an information flyer you can use to help increase awareness!
